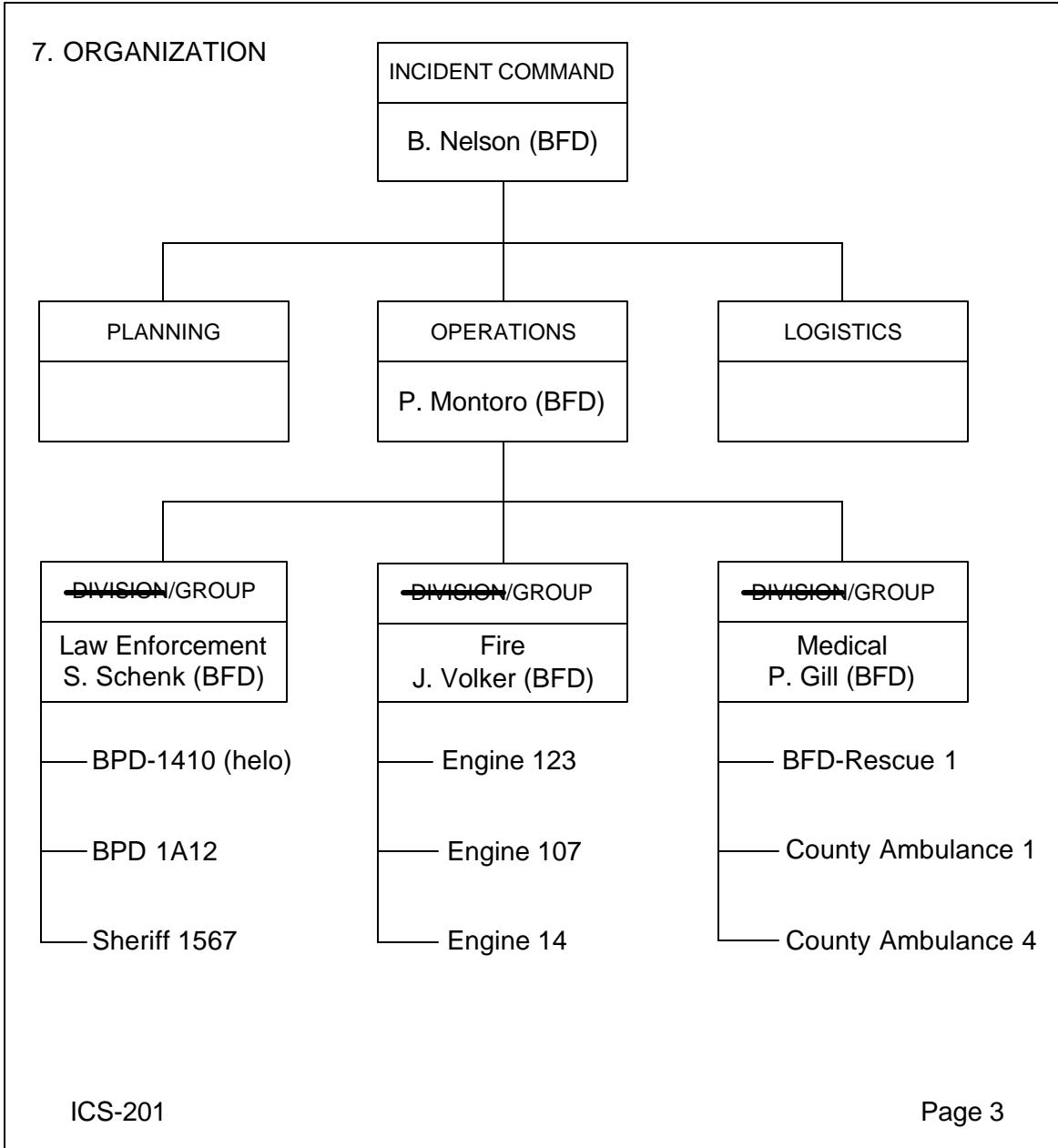


SAMPLE ICS-201 INCIDENT BRIEFING FORM

The ICS-201, Incident Briefing Form is designed for the initial Incident Commander to quickly record the incident situation, initial actions he or she has taken, the organization and resources that are on-scene, and those that have been ordered. It's an excellent document to brief incoming personnel from and to use to conduct a transfer of command.
